

Public Hearing – Town of Hammel – November 17, 2025

The public hearing on the proposed 2026 budget of the Town of Hammel was called to order by town Chairman Joe Zenner at 6:26 p.m. Monday, November 17, 2025, at the Hammel town hall. All board members were present except Supervisor Emmerich.

Residents to view as follows: Revenues- General Tax Levy \$215,140, Intergovernmental \$202,908 , Licenses and Permits, \$2,060, Public Charges for Services \$4,611, Miscellaneous \$1,900, Cash Balance Applied \$774. Total Revenue and Cash of \$427,393. Expenditures- General Government \$79,250 Public Safety \$22,000, Public Works \$228,012 Conservation & Development \$300, Debt Service \$85,613, Other Financial Uses: \$100, Taylor County (dog licenses) \$1,300, Road Fund \$10,000 Machinery Fund \$0, Contingency Fund \$0– Total Expenditures of \$426,595.

These figures were briefly discussed.
