

Town Board Meeting – Town of Hammel – May 12, 2026

The town board meeting was called to order by Chairman Zenner at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday May 12, 2026, All board members were present, The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The minutes of the April 13, 2026 town board meeting were read aloud. Chairman Zenner made a motion to approve the minutes as read. Supervisor Ecklund seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The treasurer's report was given. Supervisor Emmerich made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Supervisor Ecklund seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Open session: Nothing.

Chairman Zenner gave an update on road conditions with them being in pretty good shape. Chairman Zenner update that a spot on Center Avenue was dug out with a 180-foot soft spot that was 18-20 feet wide. It was dug out approximately 3 feet and filled with 3-inch breaker run and covered with blue rock on the top. Rhonda Seidl inquired for Angel Tyznik if anything can be done with the culvert at the end of Frank's Road as there is a bump. The Board responded that the road is very low in that spot and the water does not have anywhere to go.

Resolution from the Wisconsin Towns Association was reviewed supporting a comprehensive sustainable transportation funding solution. Supervisor Zenner made a motion for the board to sign the resolution. Supervisor Ecklund seconded the motion. The resolution numbered 05122026 will be posted and a copy sent to the Towns Association.

Chairman Zenner made a motion that we get an asphalt bid for paving the first section of Center Avenue this fall as we did not receive the LRIP grant. We will need a bid to include shouldering for one mile of 3-inch double lay and also 2-inch single lay.
